

Protective Behaviours

Process into Practice

This is a four-day course designed to consolidate and deepen participants' knowledge and understanding of the Protective Behaviours (PBs) process. Participants will have the opportunity to develop their skills and confidence as a Specialist PB Practitioner, supporting colleagues using PBs in the workplace, promoting and sustaining PBs on a wider scale within an organisation and developing PB consistent resources.

The Process into Practice Course is for people who have completed 2-day Protective Behaviours training and are currently using the PB process in the workplace. It is also for people who are interested in developing their knowledge of PBs for their own personal development. This course is a pre-requisite for anyone thinking about training to become a Protective Behaviours Trainer.
